Cycle Route 3 - Hook Norton & North Oxfordshire

Explore the churches of Hook Norton and North Oxfordshire in this 7 mile circular cycle ride that visits 5 churches.
Approximately 4.5 miles - Allow an hour and a half (allowing time to stop for 10 minutes at each church)

St Peter, Hook Norton

Begin your journey at the St Peter's. Hook Norton can be reached via public transport from Oxford, although links are not regular

This church has a history dating back to 922 AD!

Baptist Church, Hook Norton

Continue west on High Street and you'll find the Baptist Church - it's just a 30 second cycle!



Did you know?

This Baptist Church is one of the oldest in England, dating back to the 1640s.

St Mary, Swerford

Cycle out of pretty Hook Norton then weave your way along Swerford Road to discover St Mary's.



Did you know?

This church has parts dating back to the late 13th and 15th centuries. Spot the medieval features like the cusped lancet windows and the 15th century font.

St Giles, Wigginton

It's a 2 mile bike ride through winding lanes to discover St Giles, Wigginton.



Did you know?

This church boasts a beautiful Decorated Gothic nave and chancel built in the late 13th century.

Methodist Chapel, Wigginton

Cycling through this pretty village, turn left onto The Ramblers and you'll find the Methodist Chapel.



Did you know?

Wigginton Methodist Chapel is a small chapel in the middle of this tiny but attractive village which is about halfway between Chipping Norton and Banbury.
