Route into Ditchley Park from the A44

On turning off of the A44 at the Ditchley sign, drive straight up the main road, veering slightly right, until you reach a gate house with 2 black wrought iron gates at OX7 4ET. (The gates should be open, but, if not, buzz the first button on the intercom.) Then drive on and take a left at the large tree towards the front of the house. Cross a cattle grid, then take the right fork to drive around the east side of the building to the car park from there.
